### **Adoption of Agenda:**

### **Approval of Minutes:**

The Regular Meeting minutes of September 11, 2018 were approved.

### **Reports:**

## **Fayetteville Public Utilities:**

Britt Dye, CEO, reported that Phase II of the water rehab is being completed. The paving project for Bellview is nearing completion. A lot of conversion is being completed in the Blanche area. Tree trimming is being conducted around the Blanche area, as well. Letters have been sent out to customers for the telecommunication grant to determine interest in this. There are eight men going to Georgia to help with the hurricane disaster in that area. The crew that went to the Carolinas was very prepared and got to work fast and diligently to get the repairs done.

### Fire Report:

Fire Chief Coby Moon was absent, due to training. Scott Collins presented the Fire report. Mr. Collins reported that there were 110 calls for service, 81 medical calls, 4 motor vehicle accidents and with no losses to report. The hydrant flow testing has started with a hope to be completed in the next week. Building inspections will being after that. Fire Chief Coby Moon has enrolled in Fire Officer 1 and 2 certification classes and has completed and passed the 75 hour fire investigator class.

#### Police Report:

Police Chief Richard Howell was absent, no report was given.

## **Recreation Report:**

Chris Mitchell, Recreation Director, was absent. Mr. Collins presented the Recreation Report. Mr. Collins reported that Halloween Happenings will be October 23<sup>rd</sup> at 5 p.m. at Stone Bridge Park and the rain date will October 25<sup>th</sup>. The Pink in the Park dates are October 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> at Stone Bridge Park. The Bright Lights and Festive Nights at Stone Bridge Park already has a lot of excitement stirring. The city's IT Director is working with Chris Mitchell to have the Christmas lights synced to music for the display at the park this year.

#### **Public Works:**

Eddie Plunkett, Public Works Director reported that 223 tons of trash, 104 tons of brush and 2.5 tons of leaves were collected for the month of September. Please put your leaves on the street and keep them separated from the trash. Milling has started on Bellview Avenue, and a portion has been paved.

## **Planning and Codes Report:**

Eddie Plunkett reported that 18 permits were issued, with permit fees being \$8,593.00, with a total project evaluation of \$1,781,658.00. There have been 535 violations issued and approximately 75% of those have been resolved.

### **Administrator's Report:**

Scott Collins, City Administrator, reported that the Fourth Annual Cruzin' was a huge event. The TAP grant for Phase I, is set to go to bid pending approval of the Board. Construction will start in early spring. The Phase II is wrapping up the environmental stage of the requirement process. Camp Blount is really moving forward, although we still have a tenant that will still be at the entrance site. Preliminary work is getting ready to start, and a meeting is scheduled with the engineers concerning Phase II so that a smooth, coordinated effort will be conducted. A lot of pieces are falling into place.

### **Parks and Recreation Coordinator Position:**
