CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, TN

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation has responsibility for the administration of the Tennessee Department of Transportation-Transportation Alternatives program (TA) which is designed to assist communities in their efforts to enhance transportation concerns.

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville, acting by and through its Board of Aldermen proposes to apply for TA funds for the purpose of performing eligible transportation enhancement activities that will benefit the majority of the residents of the City of Fayetteville.

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville will provide local financial support in conjunction with the TA funds to complete the project, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fayetteville, as a recipient is required to designate and appoint a Financial Officer to perform certain duties in the administration of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Fayetteville as follows:

THAT, Mayor Jon Law is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation, requesting Fiscal Year 2017 TA funds for the 2017 City of Fayetteville Downtown Improvement Project.

THAT, the City of Fayetteville will be responsible for the local cash /match toward the project to be provide in full by the general account; and

THAT, Mayor Jon Law be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer and to perform on behalf of the City of Fayetteville, Tennessee, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
